
A NEW PLAN FOR MERIDEN

- Would you like to have a greater say about what happens in your Parish?
- Are you concerned about our local schools, shops, health facilities, traffic or parking, and would like to do something about it?
- If so you may be interested in a new Plan for Meriden.

A NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

The Government has passed legislation that allows local people to come together to prepare a new type of plan for their area. These 'Neighbourhood Plans' allow communities to plan for and guide development in their area.

Meriden Neighbourhood Planning Group are seeking the views of residents, businesses and community organisations to see if you support the preparation of a community led plan for Meriden. A Neighbourhood Forum must be formed to take the plan forward and Solihull Council must help us to prepare the plan.



What will the Plan do?

The content of the Plan is up to local people to decide how the Parish will develop over the next 15 years and set out policies to achieve the vision. It might for example allocate sites for school expansion, affordable housing for local people and new health services.

It could look at road and parking improvements and identify green spaces for protection including heritage sites.

In short it will enable residents to see more of what they want and ensure that monies raised from local developments are spent locally for the benefit of our residents and wider community.
