

NOTICE UNDER LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (1972 (Section 87(2)))

VACANCY FOR A PARISH COUNCILLOR
PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN

A casual vacancy has occurred in the office of Councillor for the Parish of Meriden.

Rule 5(2) of The Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) (England and Wales) Rules 2006 stipulates the vacancy will only be filled by election if a request from TEN local government electors for the Parish is received within FOURTEEN days of this notice. The fourteen-day period ends on Tuesday 11th June 2024.

Requests for an election should include each electors name and address and should be sent to the returning officer at the address below:

What if a request to hold an election is not received during the permitted time?

If no such notice is given, Rule 5(5) of The Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) (England and Wales) Rules 2006 apply and the Parish Council shall fill the vacancy by co-option.
